THE DEADLY HURRICANES

A couple weeks ago, Hurricane Katrina headed toward the gulf coast. It hit New Orleans which is built seven feet below sea level. They have a levee around New Orleans; when the hurricane hit New Orleans, it brought so much rain that the levee broke and the "bath tub" filled up. Katrina brought wind up to 150 miles per hour. It damaged the coasts of Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama. It destroyed many homes and businesses. Now thousands of people are homeless. Because the Mayor of New Orleans did not demand a mandatory evacuation, about 900 people died. About two weeks later, the mayor allowed people to return to New Orleans--just in time for the arrival of hurricane Rita, which was a level three hurricane. Rita came ashore on the Texas coastline. Rita broke the repaired levee again in New Orleans. The gulf coast damage is in the billions, plus the damage to the oil industry.
